Special Board of Trustees meeting to review Township precinct consolidation, Banking Fraud protection and Computer bid upgrades

- 1. The board discussed the banking fraud protection. The board discussed fraud protection which Incredible bank offers for business accounts. This protects against external threats like check fraud. Because the township deals with a high amounts of checks and there are many days when people are unable to check the accounts, it is recommended that we buy this fraud protection. A motion was made by Fink, seconded by Smith to approve of the township spending \$60.00 to set up for fraud protection and \$1200.00 per year to protect two accounts against fraud. - 3. New Forbearance agreement with the City of Houghton.

 Petersen passed out a new forbearance agreement with the City of Houghton, including an updated bill of \$60141.47 for the month of April.
- 4. New Computer software/hardware upgrades Betsy presented the board with the three bids for new computers, software, hardware, backups & support. After discussion Up&Running had the best bid for \$ 16,429.99 for the new equipment and installation + \$ 4,488.00 per year for the close watch system, which includes windows updates, security licenses, managed backups, labor and more.
